William L. Berg, President and CEO of Dairyland Power Cooperative, is a lifelong resident of Wisconsin. He is a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Wisconsin and a member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers.

From 1972 to 1974, Mr. Berg was employed by Wisconsin Electric Power Company, Milwaukee, in various engineering capacities. Mr. Berg has been employed by Dairyland since 1974, and assumed the duties of chief executive officer in 1990.

Mr. Berg serves on a variety of boards and committees, including the Board of Directors of GEN~SYS Energy and the Board of Advisors of Viterbo University and its Executive Committee. He currently serves as Co-Chairman of the Rail Energy Transportation Advisory Committee of the Surface Transportation Board of the U.S. Department of Transportation.
